NOTICE OF CONSTRUCTION

**Balfour Avenue 3100 block (Maddock Avenue to Burnside Road)
Speed Hump Installation - November 2020**

The City of Victoria is delivering neighbourhood traffic calming measures city-wide to address issues on local streets, as part of a new traffic calming program. Following ongoing concerns from residents, the City collected traffic data for 3100 block Balfour on vehicle speeds and volumes on the block and identified the street as a candidate for speed humps. This block of Balfour Avenue is noticeably inconsistent within the local traffic calming network as it is one of few blocks lacking speed humps.

A letter was mailed to 3100 block residents in July 2020 requesting feedback on a speed hump proposal, with general support indicated. Weather permitting, the City will proceed with construction the week of November 2nd 2020, expected to last one to two days. This may be subject to change, as City of Victoria construction crews manage changing priorities day-to-day during the COVID-19 pandemic.

Extent of Work Zone



The scope of works includes the installation of three speed humps and the installation of speed hump signage. The City of Victoria will work to minimize inconvenience during construction. Local access will be maintained; however parking restrictions and traffic diversions may be required at times.
