NOTICE OF CONSTRUCTION

**Irma Street, from Lotus Street to Gorge Road
Storm and Sanitary Sewer Main Construction
January – March 2021**

Dear Sir/Madam:

In 2021, the City of Victoria is completing a number of storm drain and sanitary sewer infrastructure upgrades designed to improve capacity and resilience to the existing systems.

Work to replace an existing storm drain and an existing sanitary sewer main on Irma Street, and a portion of an existing sanitary main on Lotus Street is scheduled to commence Mid- January, 2021, and is expected to last approximately 10 weeks.

Project upgrades include:

- **Sanitary Sewer:** This project includes the replacement of approx. 105 metres of an existing vitrified clay sanitary sewer main with a 200mm PVC pipe on Irma Street, and approx. 20 metres of 200mm PVC on Lotus Street.
- **Storm Sewer:** This project includes the replacement of approx. 105 metres of an existing vitrified clay storm drain main with a 250mm PVC pipe on Irma Street.
- **Restoration:** This project includes restoration of the disturbed asphalt, sidewalk, and boulevards.

The City will work to minimize any inconvenience during construction. Access may be delayed during work hours, with parking restrictions and traffic diversions required for the project.
