Ops & Finance

Suzanne shared operational highlights:

- The audit is set for the week of November 14. Preparations have started early this year because it's a new team.
- To address a staff shortage in Childcare two programs have combined to run out of the Burnside site temporarily.
- The management team has formalized a Use of Personal Vehicle policy to ensure that staff are adequately covered by insurance when using their personal vehicles for work.

Prospective Board Member Benji introduced himself to the group. He lives in the neighbourhood and is opening pet store on Burnside. He currently works at Victoria Native Friendship Centre in their shelter program and has a background working with vulnerable single populations.

City Updates

Gary shared staff update:

- The City is in the process of drafting the new Rock Bay Industrial Zone as outlined in the neighbourhood plan.
- My Great Neighbourhood Grants are oversubscribed in the fall intake, the City has received 27
 applications.

- Selkirk Montessori School is working on a project in Cecelia Cove to install natural play scape features (stumps for climbing, logs, boulders, etc). They are currently working through design and finding an appropriate scale for the project.
- There was a 43% voter turnout for the election in Victoria.

Geoff does not have a date for when Neighbourhood Liaison roles will be reassigned for the new council. He suggested acquainting new councillors with the specific neighbourhood issues, objectives of the organization, and what community priorities funding is desired for.

There was general discussion around inviting new councillors to a meeting to make the connection and introduce them to the neighbourhood. Gary offered to organize a walk-shop.

ACTION: Suzanne will work with Avery to draft an email to new councillors to invite them.

New Business

Ride for Refuge

- BGCA's goal for this year was exceeded, with \$11,000 raised. Avery thanked everyone for participating.
- There was general discussion about whether the event is the best fit and whether BGCA should explore some sort of dedicated fundraising efforts that will contribute 100% to BGCA.
