**NOTICE OF CONSTRUCTION**

**Burnside Road at Washington Avenue  
Traffic Signal Crosswalk Upgrades  
October 2017 – November 2017**

Dear Sir/ Madam,

The City of Victoria will be improving the crosswalk at Burnside Road and Washington Avenue. Construction is tentatively scheduled to begin in the middle of October and is expected to be completed by the end of November. The improvements for this project are as follows:

- **Crosswalk Upgrades:**

Installation of a new streetlight and button activated flashing beacons will provide a more visible crossing for the pedestrian corridor.

- **Wheelchair Ramp Upgrades:**

The south wheelchair ramps will be reconstructed for pole installation and brought up to current City Standard to improve accessibility.

- **Pavement & Boulevard Restoration:**

Areas adjacent to construction will be repaired as required.

The City of Victoria will work to minimize inconveniences during construction. Local access will be maintained and some parking restrictions will be required. The construction area will be clearly marked with signs.
