NOTICE OF CONSTRUCTION

**Cecelia Ravine Park Improvements
July 30, 2018 – December 2018**

Dear Sir/Madam:

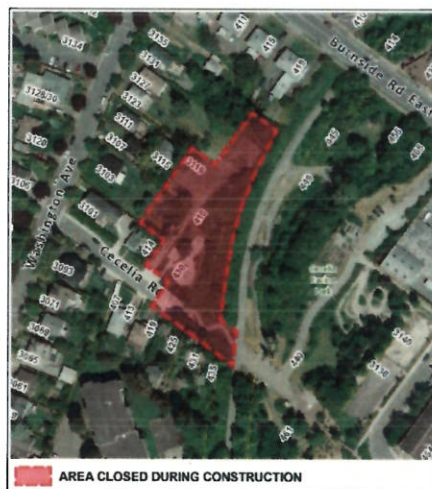
This summer, the City of Victoria will be constructing improvements in a portion of Cecelia Ravine Park, located off Cecelia Road (west). These improvements will include:

- A larger, more accessible, playground and improved outdoor fitness area;
- New community gathering areas, picnic facilities and open green space;
- A small parking lot for vehicles;
- A small public washroom; and,
- An upgraded multi-use pathway at the end of Cecelia Road (west), making it easier for pedestrians and cyclists to access the rest of the park and the Galloping Goose Trail.

Park construction - scheduled to begin the week of July 30 and be completed in December.

Pathway construction (between Cecelia Road (west) and the Galloping Goose Trail) - expected to begin in September and be completed in December. Pathway access at the end of Cecelia Road (west) will be closed during construction. The Galloping Goose Trail will remain open throughout construction. Trail users should access the Galloping Goose Trail via Burnside Road East, or Gorge Road East.

The City of Victoria will work to minimize any impacts to residents during construction. The construction area will be clearly marked with signs and closed to the public.
